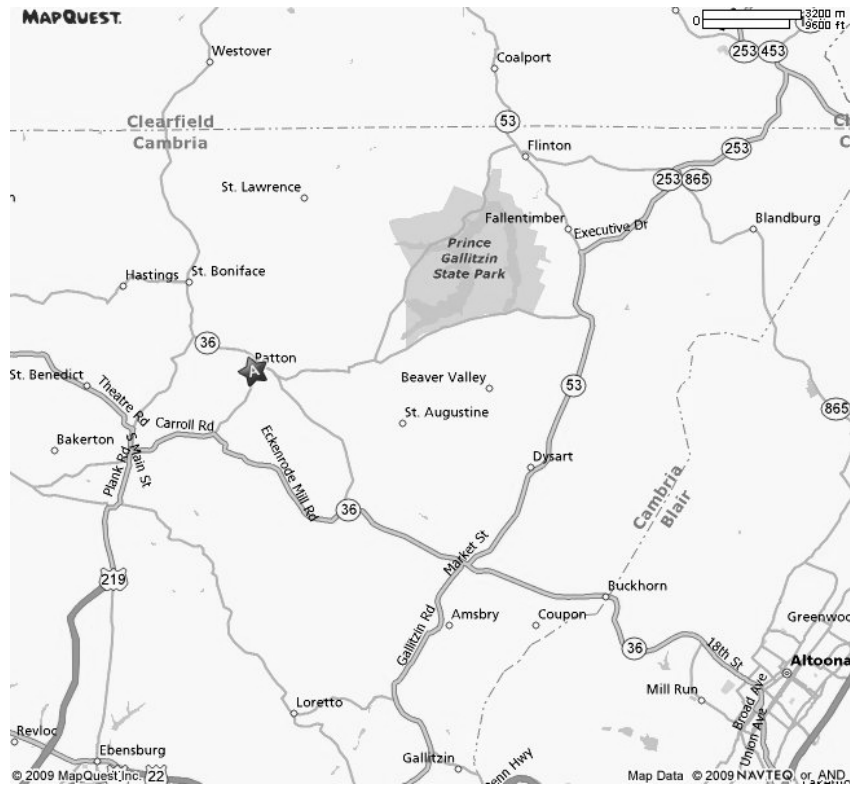

It is along **Beaver Valley Road** in the Pickerel Pond Day Use Area (also known as Children's Play Area), about 3/4 mile north of the Crooked Run Campground.
